Ampco Care and Cleaning Instructions

SOLID SURFACE RESTROOM COMPARTMENTS

The following information should be used a guideline to preserve your Ampco solid surface restroom compartments.

Protecting the Surface

Solid surface material used in your toilet partition system with glossy or matte surface have a non-porous solid surfacing composed of acrylic and/or polyesther components with an aluminum trihydrate filler.

While solid surface are impervious to normal wear and moist environment, they can be damaged if they are subjected to extraordinary abuse. Pounding directly on solid surface can result in breakage of material.

Cleaning the Surface

<u>Matte Finishes</u> - Use household powered cleanser or non-abrasive ScotchBrite pad.

Glossy Finishes - Use soap and water or liquid detergent.

Do not use abrasive cleaners or rough scouring pads or steel wool
to clean solid surface finishes. Acid and alkaline-based solutions
such as drain cleaners, chlorine bleach, metal cleaners, and oven
cleaners will permanently damage solid surface and should not be
allowed to come into contact with solid surfaces.
